




CASTING OFF

Have you ever tied up to a tree on an island and gone for a walk? Then, when you return, your boat is high and dry because the tide has gone out while you are walking around now; you need to wait for the tide to return, which could be at night.

By following this simple diagram, you'll be able to tie up safely and then pull your boat in safely when you return without damaging it or needing to wait for the tide to come back, which could be after dark.

Remember, safe boating is a priority and a responsibility for all boaters, including those at the Sheet Harbor Marina.
